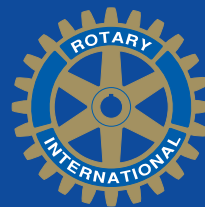

MALARIA AWARENESS DAY

30TH APRIL

Malaria is one of the World's deadliest diseases. Rotary has joined the World Health Organization (W.H.O.) in it's global partnership "Roll-Back Malaria" campaign. It is a formidable challenge; some half a billion people will be infected by malaria each year of whom over 3000 will die each day.

Rotarians in Australia are working with the W.H.O., AusAid, and the relevant governmental agencies in Papua New Guinea and the Solomon Islands to reduce the incidence of malaria. These anti malaria programs are working well and where implemented the rate of malaria is steadily declining.

Chemically impregnated bed nets assist enormously in reducing the incidence of malaria and \$10 will purchase a bed net.

The W.H.O. recognises the 25th April each year as "World Malaria Day". In Australia this date conflicts with ANZAC Day so 30th April is the rationale for our "Malaria Awareness Day".
